




Q1 '14 Jet Turns North of MacDill A.F.B.

- Commercial & Cargo = 133
- Corporate = 42
- Jet turns north of MacDill's Runway 4 represented approximately 1.6% of the total arrivals (10,733) during a north flow this quarter.



Comparison to CY Q1 '13

- → Jet landings on Runways 1R & 1L combined, increased by 308 from 10,425.
- Commercial and Cargo jet pilot requested landings on Runway 1R decreased by 48 from 159 to 111. Corporate pilots requested landings decreased by 39 from 131.
- → FAA assigned landings decreased by **21** from 44 to 23.
- → Overall, jet landings on Runway 1R increased by 529 due in large part to the daily closures of Runway 1L for 12 days.

**Runway 1L-19R was closed to landings for several days due to the Airfield Drainage Project.

***Runway 1L-19R was closed on Sept. 23, 2013 for Construction and reopened on Oct. 22, 2013.

****Runway 1L-19R was closed daily from 7 am to 7 pm from March 3, to March 14, 2014.

Comparison to CY Q1 '13:


- → FAA assigned departures increased by **18.**
- → Pilot requested departures decreased by **11** or from 17 to six.
- → Airport Issues assigned departures increased by 451 or from 366 to 817 due to the daily closures of Runway 1L-19R for 12 days.



Q1 '14 Noise Complaints

Total of 64 noise complaints from 21 individual households

- Exactly the same number of complaints compared to the previous quarter.
- 5 fewer complaints, but an increase of 6 households compared to the same quarter a year ago.
- Eight repeat callers accounted for 51 or 80% of the total complaints.
- Frequent types of noise complaints:
 - ➢ 50% Jet Landings on Runway 1R
 - ▶ 17% Loud
- Geographical location of majority of noise complaints:
 - → Beach Park 30
 - → Areas N, NE and NW of Airport 5
 - → South of Gandy Blvd 7
 - → Sunset Park & Belmar Shores 5
 - → Dana Shores 8
