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## Noise Monitoring Office Update

### December Runway Closures

- Runway Grooving and Sealing on Both Runways:
  - Runway 1L/19R
    - December 10<sup>th</sup> 8am 5pm
    - December 16<sup>th</sup> 8am–5pm
    - December 17<sup>th</sup> 8am 10am
  - Runway 1R/19L
    - December 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> 8am 5pm
    - December 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> 8am 5 pm
    - December 17<sup>th</sup> 11am 5pm



## West Runway Closure

- Runway 1L/19R was closed on January 14<sup>th</sup> 2021.
  - Closed to facilitate multiple runway maintenance items including:
    - FAA Technical Operations
      - RWY 19R approach lighting Repairs
      - ILS Maintenance
      - Ground Checks
    - Runway shoulder repair
    - Light Cleaning/Adjustments



## Runway Maintenance (cont'd)



### East Runway Closure

- A Runway 1R/19L is planned on January 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>th</sup> 2021.
  - Closed to facilitate multiple runway maintenance items including:
    - FAA Technical Operations
      - ILS Maintenance
      - Ground Checks
    - Runway spall repairs
    - Shoulder Marking painting
    - Light Cleaning/Adjustments



### Upcoming **Prolonged** 2021 Runway Closures

- Extended closures on **both** parallel runways are tentatively planned for the second half of 2021.
   Dates to be determined and will be communicated once they are finalized:
  - Closures are necessary for re-grading work on the south ends of both parallel runways that cannot be accomplished per regulatory requirements with the runways open to air traffic.
  - Runway closures are expected to last several weeks.





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## Noise Exposure Map Update

#### Noise Exposure Map Update

- The Authority is in the process of formally updating the Airport's Noise Exposure Map.
- This project formally kicked off in late 2019.
- Due to COVID-19, public outreach was delayed until October 2020.
- A second round of public outreach is planned for the first half of 2021.
- The project is currently expected to be completed in 2021.



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## Metroplex (NextGen)

### Metroplex (NextGen) – Key Facts



- Congressional mandate to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to transform the National Airspace System.
- Primary component is implementation of Performance Based Navigation (PBN), moving away from ground based navigation to satellite based navigation.
- South-Central Florida implementation (including TPA) are expected over the next 12 months.
- Majority of NextGen expected to be <u>fully implemented in 2021</u>.





## Metroplex Implementation Coming in 2021



- FAA is the agency implementing congressionally mandated modernization of the National Airspace System.
- The FAA completed their second round of public outreach over the summer of 2021:
  - The FAA's Finding of No Significant Impact was formally filed in late
     October 2020
  - Procedure changes will begin in early 2021
  - Majority of changes around TPA are at or above 10,000 ft.







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## FAA's Noise Annoyance Survey

#### Overview

- As part of FAA's ongoing research program on aircraft noise, the Agency conducted a nationwide survey regarding annoyance related to aircraft noise.
- This survey was conducted in 2015 and 2016.
- The survey was released in early January 2021.
- Survey suggests that noise annoyance occurs at lower noise levels than current federal methodology, in place since the 1970's, accounts for.
- The Noise Annoyance Survey itself will not dictate a change in federal guidelines for noise annoyance and will be coupled with additional research and community engagement.
- There is currently no change to the 65 DNL metric being the baseline for land use compatibility and/or significant noise impact.
- There is a 60 day public comment period on the Federal Register Notice.
