Safety






 - December 55% South Flow








Airport Flow (cont'd)

West Runway Closures

- Runway 1L/19R:
 - Various Maintenance activities November 10 : 8 am 12 pm
 - Various Maintenance activities December 6 & 7 : 8 am 6 pm





East Runway Closures

- Runway 1R/19L:
 - Various Maintenance activities November 16 & 17 : 8 am
 4 pm
 - Various Maintenance activities December 15 : 7 am 3 pm





Emergency Response Closure

- Corporate Jet December 21:
 - Issue: Tire Failure
 - Aircraft Landed Safety and a tire became flat on Runway 1L at 1:40 am
 - The Aircraft taxied to the gate
 - Runway was closed for approximately
 40 minutes for clean up





Upcoming Prolonged 2022 Runway Closures

- Extended closures on **both** parallel runways are tentatively planned for the first half of 2022. Current dates are noted below:
 - 1R-19L: January 5 February 18, 2022
 - 1L-19R: April 20 June 3, 2022
- Closures are necessary for re-grading work on the south ends of both parallel runways that cannot be accomplished per regulatory requirements with the runways open to air traffic.
 - Runway closures are expected to last several weeks each and will be <u>continuous</u> closures (~45 days)

Reminder – Scheduled Monthly Runway Closures

1st Wednesday of every month – Runway 1L-19R Closed between 7:30 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.

3rd Wednesday of every month – Runway 1R-19L Closed between 7:30 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.

Note: Runway closure dates, times and lengths are subject to change
