

Safety

- Restrooms:

Top Complaints During the Period

February 1, 2020 through November 30, 2020

- West Runway Closure (August 10 thru September 4)
- Early Westerly Turns (North Flow Departures)
- Non-TPA Flight Complaints



West Runway Closure

- Runway 1L/19R was closed continuously from August 10th through September 4th.
 - Closed to facilitate multiple runway maintenance items including:
 - Runway slab replacement
 - Runway lighting replacement
 - Runway Safety Area work
 - Taxiway Sign Replacement

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East Runway Closure

- Runway 1R/19L was closed continuously on September 9th and reopened on November 19th.
 - Closed to facilitate multiple runway maintenance items including:
 - Runway slab replacement
 - Runway lighting replacement
 - Taxiway Milling and overlay of a taxiway connector to the runway.

December Closures


- Runway Grooving and Sealing on Both Runways:
 - Runway 1L/19R
 - December 10th 8am 5pm December 16th 8am 5pm December 17th 8am – 10am
 - Runway 1R/19L
 - December 8th & 9th 8am 5pm December 14th & 15th 8am
 5 pm December 17th 11am 5pm





Air Traffic Volume – 2019 vs. 2020

- Air Traffic was down 46% for the period due to the Pandemic.
 - Deviations increased during the extended runway closures.






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Deviation Volume – 2019 vs. 2020

- Deviations increased during the extended runway closures.
 - East Runway Deviations from August 10th to September 4th
 - Early Westbound Turn
 Deviations September 9th
 thru October 31st

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2021 Closures

- Extended closures on both runways are tentatively planned for the second half of 2021. Dates to be determined and will be communicated once they are finalized.
 - Closures are necessary for significant regrading work on the sound ends of both parallel runways that cannot be accomplished per regulatory requirements with the runways open.







Noise Exposure Map Update

Noise Exposure Map Update

- The Authority is in the process of formally updating the Airport's Noise Exposure Map
- This project formally kicked off in late 2019
- Due to COVID-19, public outreach was delayed until October 2020
- A second round of public outreach is planned for early 2021
- The project is expected to be completed in 2021





Metroplex (NextGen)

Metroplex (NextGen) – Key Facts



- Congressional mandate to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to transform the National Airspace System.
- Primary component is implementation of Performance Based Navigation (PBN), moving away from ground based navigation to satellite based navigation.
- South-Central Florida implementation (including TPA) are expected over the next 12 months.
- Majority of NextGen expected to be <u>fully implemented by 2021</u>.





Metroplex Implementation Coming in 2021

- FAA is the agency implementing congressionally mandated modernization of the National Airspace System.
- The FAA completed their second round of public outreach this past summer:
 - The FAA's Finding of No Significant Impact was formally filed in late October
 - Procedure changes will begin in 2021
 - Majority of changes around TPA are at or above 10,000 ft.

Reminder – Scheduled Monthly Runway Closures

1st Wednesday of every month – Runway 1L-19R Closed between 7:30 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.

3rd Wednesday of every month – Runway 1R-19L Closed between 7:30 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.
