

Runway 1R Jet Landings – July – August 2017






Jet Pilot Compliance – Commercial and Corporate Jets July – August 2017

Jet Landings By The Numbers July – August 2017






Jet Departures and Arrivals - Parallel Runways

July 2017 – August 2017: Jet **Landings** on Runway 19R and 19L (Landing from the north to south)






July 2017 – August 2017: Jet **Departures** on Runway 19R and 19L (Departing to the south)





July 2017 – August 2017: Jet **Departures** Runway 1L and 1R (Departing to the north)






July 2017 – August 2017: Departure Heading Compliance – North Flow Departures Runway 1L

- Previous survey was completed in the fall of 2016.






Response Count and County of Residence

Summer 2017:

 55 respondents to the June 2017 survey with a 90.9% completion rate.

Fall 2016:

 62 respondents with an 89.9% completion rate.




1. In which county do you primarily reside?





2. Which of the following best describes your residential location relative to Tampa International Airport?





- Majority of respondents identified living south of the Airport.
- Compared to 2016 survey, residents who identify themselves as north of the Airport rose by 3% and those identifying themselves west of the Airport increased by 14%.

3. Which of the following would you say is the most problematic time of day for aircraft noise from aircraft arriving to, or departing from Tampa International Airport for your neighborhood?

Evening (6:00pm - 11:00pm)	41.3%	19
Overnight (11:01pm - 5:00am)	6.5%	3


Time of day selections remained flat, with a drop noted in those selecting 'overnight' hours and an increase in those selecting 'evening' hours as being most problematic for aircraft noise.

Filing Noise Complaints





• Responses were in line with those from 2016. Of note, there was a 10% increase to those selecting having filed a noise complaint one time, suggesting an increase in first-time complainants.

6. Have you previously visited the Airport's website regarding the Airport Voluntary Noise Abatement Program?


Visiting the Airport's Website

Helpfulness of Noise Webpages





- 71% of respondents were neutral to the Airport's website or had positive feelings about the noise abatement web pages.
 - This is a 10% improvement compared to the fall 2016 survey.



9. Were you aware of, and have you attended any of the Airport's facilitated public Community Noise Consortium (CNC) meetings?




 Responses in line with the fall 2016 survey. Of note, there was a 5% reduction in those stating they were unfamiliar with the CNC meetings.


CNC Meeting Attendance Frequency



• Compared to the 2016 survey, there was an 8% increase in those saying they believe the CNC meetings were valuable and a 20% increase in those saying they believe the CNC meetings are not valuable at all.

12. How would you rate Tampa International Airport's level of engagement with the community with respect to noise related issues?




- 64% of respondents stated they believe the Airport is engaged on noise related matters.
 - This marks a 10% increase to the fall 2016 survey.
- A 12% increase was noted in those saying they believe the Airport is 'very engaged' on noise related matters.

Metroplex (NextGen)


Metroplex (NextGen) – Key Facts



- Congressional mandate to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to transform the National Airspace System.
- Primary component is implementation of Performance Based Navigation (PBN), moving away from ground based navigation to satellite based navigation.
- South-Central Florida implementation (including TPA) not expected for at least 24-36 months.
- Majority of NextGen expected to be <u>fully implemented by 2020</u>.



More to Come on Metroplex...





- Airport last met with the FAA regarding Metroplex in February 2017.
- The FAA advised the Airport in April that an internal FAA timeline for outreach and community engagement was being reevaluated. No further information has been provided.
- Hillsborough County Aviation Authority is committed to:
 - Community engagement on Metroplex.
 - Making sure residents and stakeholders are involved in the process to the greatest extent possible allowed by the FAA.
 - We welcome the opportunity to engage with your HOA to help encourage your community to participate in public FAA meetings, when they are scheduled.

Scheduled Runway Closures

Reminder - Scheduled Runway Closures

1st Wednesday of every month – Runway 1L-19R Closed between 7:30 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.

3rd Wednesday of every month – Runway 1R-19L Closed between 7:30 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.

Note: A closure of the Airport's west runway for a period of up to 14 days is expected to occur within the next 3 to 6 months. Dates are unknown at this time and will be communicated in advance, once final runway impacts are known.

Note: Runway closure dates, times and lengths are subject to change
