


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Noise Monitoring Office Update

Runway 1R Jet Landings

The FAA Tower cleared **9% fewer** jet landings on Runway 1R year-over-year.




Inclusive of Commercial and Corporate Jet Landings



Commercial Jet Pilot Compliance May – June, 2017

- For May and June, 2017, commercial jet pilot compliance was 99.9%.
 - The FAA Tower cleared 30 commercial jet pilot request deviations out of 25,852 commercial jet landings and departures for the period.



Note: Deviations are for all air carriers which include requests to depart Runway 19L and land Runway 1R.




Corporate Jet Pilot Compliance

May – June, 2017

- Corporate jet operations accounted for 10% of the total jet operations at TPA for the reported period.
- Corporate jet aircraft were 94%
 compliant with the Airport's
 Voluntary Noise Abatement
 Program for the reported period.








Jet Landings By The Numbers... May – June, 2017

South Flow:

 During 'south' flow operations, jet landings are split between Runway 19R and Runway 19L.

North Flow:

 During 'north' flow operations, jet landings are concentrated to Runway 1L.








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
Jet Departures and Arrivals - Parallel Runways

May 2017 – June 2017: Jet **Landings** on Runway 19R and 19L (Landing from the north to south)






May 2017 – June 2017: Jet **Departures** on Runway 19R and 19L (Departing to the south)





May 2017 – June 2017: Jet **Departures** Runway 1L and 1R (Departing to the north)






May 2017 – June 2017: Departure Heading Compliance – North Flow Departures Runway 1L

Total Jet Departures Runway 1L: 2,237

Total Deviations: 39

Compliance: 98%

 - Improved analytics.
 - Opportunities to customize the application to maximize transparency and community awareness.

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Metroplex (NextGen)


Metroplex (NextGen) – Key Facts



- Congressional mandate to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to transform the National Airspace System.
- Primary component is implementation of Performance Based Navigation (PBN), moving away from ground based navigation to satellite based navigation.
- South-Central Florida implementation (including TPA) not expected for at least 24-36 months.
- Majority of NextGen expected to be <u>fully implemented by 2020</u>.



More to Come on Metroplex...





- Airport last met with the FAA regarding Metroplex in February 2017.
- The FAA advised the Airport in April that an internal FAA timeline for outreach and community engagement was being reevaluated. No further information has been provided.
- Hillsborough County Aviation Authority is committed to:
 - Community engagement on Metroplex.
 - Making sure residents and stakeholders are involved in the process to the greatest extent possible allowed by the FAA.
 - We welcome the opportunity to engage with your HOA to help encourage your community to participate in public FAA meetings, when they are scheduled.
