
# **Tampa International Airport Monthly Noise Monitoring Office Report** July 2019


#### **Community Outreach – July 2019:**

- The Airport hosted a Noise Abatement 101 offering in Carrollwood on July 16, 2019.
- The Airport hosted two Community Noise Forum meetings on July 18, 2019.

### **Upcoming Operational Impacts:**

- The Airport's west runway, Runway 1L/19R is expected to be closed continuously for a period of time in October, 2019. Specific dates of the closure are not yet known but will be communicated as soon as they are finalized.
- The Airport continues to evaluate the scheduled monthly maintenance closures that take place the first and third Wednesday of each month. These scheduled runway closures will likely be enhanced to allow more frequent routine maintenance activities, with the goal of reducing the continuous runway closures that take place periodically each year. More information will be communicated in the coming weeks.
