
• The Airport will host a Noise 101 meeting at the Jan Platt Library on Tuesday, December 2, 2019.

Operational Impacts:

- Due to taxiway work affecting the movement of aircraft between the west and east side of the Airfield, Air Traffic Control landed additional traffic on Runway 1R during north flow operations. This accounted for approximately half of the deviations for the month.
- Runway 10-28 is closed until December 15, 2019 for the installation of runway guard lights.
