
# **Tampa International Airport Monthly Noise Monitoring Office Report** October 2018

### **Monthly Noise Report:**


#### Airfield:

- The Airport's west runway, Runway 1L/19R, was closed continuously from October 8 through October 27 and during daytime hours from October 29 through November 4. During this time, the majority of the Airport's air traffic landed and departed from the east runway.
- A large section of Taxiway W, the primary taxiway adjacent to the Airport's west runway, was closed on April 12. The project is expected to be completed in December 2018.
- As a result of the current Taxiway W construction project, there is an increase in the use of the Airport's east runway (Runway 1R/19L) for arriving aircraft in South Flow operations and an increase in departing aircraft in North Flow operations.

#### **Community Outreach:**

The next CNC meetings are scheduled for Thursday, November 8, 2018, with two meeting times: 9:30 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. and again from 5:30 p.m. until 6:30 p.m.

-West Runway Unavailable includes closures for maintenances and emergencies, among other factors.
