



Monthly Noise Report:

Airfield:

- A large section of Taxiway W, the primary taxiway adjacent to the Airport's west runway, was closed on April 12. The first phase of this taxiway project, which is replacing asphalt with concrete, is expected to be completed in September 2018.
- As a result of the current Taxiway W
 construction project, there is an increase in
 the use of the Airport's east runway (Runway
 1R/19L) for arriving aircraft in South Flow
 operations and an increase in departing
 aircraft in North Flow operations.
- Runway use deviations increased in late
 August due to a steady weather pattern of
 heavy afternoon thunderstorms. This led to
 runway use deviations and some departure
 heading deviations due to the presence of
 storms in the area.
- The Airport's west runway, Runway 1L/19R, is expected to be closed 24/7 from October 8 through October 28 for an ongoing taxiway project. Additional daytime closures are expected from October 29 through November 4.
