
Tampa International Airport Monthly Noise Monitoring Office Report December 2017





Monthly Noise Report:

- Pilot compliance (corporate and commercial combined) was 99.2%, with 121 total pilot request deviations recorded for the month out of 15,265 total jet operations.
- The increase in deviations in December was largely driven by the Airport's west runway being closed for 12 hours each day for runway maintenance activity from December 1, 2017 through December 13, 2017.
- Starting January 15, 2018 through February 19, 2018, the Airport's east runway (Runway 1R/19L) will be closed continuously for runway maintenance activity.
- The next Community Noise Consortium (CNC) meetings will be held on January 18, 2018 from 9:30 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. and from 5:30 p.m. until 6:30 p.m.
