
Tampa International Airport Monthly Noise Monitoring Office Report October 2017





Monthly Noise Report:

- Pilot compliance (corporate and commercial combined) was 98.4%, with 209 total pilot request deviations recorded for the month, out of 13,399 total jet operations.
- The Airport operated in a North Flow for the majority of October.
- The Airport launched its new Noise Monitoring Office software system on October 1, 2017.
- Next CNC meetings are scheduled for Thursday, November 9, 2017 from 9:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. and from 5:30 p.m. until 6:30 p.m. There will also be a Noise 101 offering for residents on November 9 from 4:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m.

Total Jet Arrivals Runway 10: 3


Total Jet Departures Runway 28: Δ
