Top Complaints During the Period

November 1 through December 31, 2019

- West Runway Closures.
- Holiday Traffic (volume).

West Runway Closure

- Runway 1L/19R was closed daily from December 16 through December 20.
 - Closed to facilitate multiple runway maintenance items including:
 - Rubber removal
 - Runway lighting maintenance
 - Runway Safety Area work
 - Taxiway Sign Replacement






Rubber Removal



Holiday Air Traffic Volume – 2018 vs. 2019

- In spite of the increase in total jet traffic, commercial pilot request deviations were down 42% YOY for the period:
 - General Aviation (corporate jet)
 pilot request deviations
 increased for the period YOY

Noise Exposure Map Update

- The Authority is in the process of formally updating the Airport's Noise Exposure
 Map
- This project formally kicked off in late 2019
- Public outreach is slated to begin in the coming months
 - More information will be communicated as dates are finalized
- There will be at least two separate rounds of public outreach
- The project is expected to be completed in 2021



Metroplex (NextGen)

Metroplex (NextGen) – Key Facts



- Congressional mandate to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to transform the National Airspace System.
- Primary component is implementation of Performance Based Navigation (PBN), moving away from ground based navigation to satellite based navigation.
- South-Central Florida implementation (including TPA) not expected for at least 18-24 months.
- Majority of NextGen expected to be <u>fully implemented by 2021</u>.





More to Come on Metroplex...

- FAA is the agency implementing congressionally mandated modernization of the National Airspace System.
- The FAA held their first round of public meetings in our area between April 29 and May 2, 2019.
 - This is the first of two rounds of meetings
 - The FAA will now be conducting an environmental assessment on their procedural enhancements around our airspace
 - The FAA is expected to return for another round of public meetings in Spring/Summer 2020
- The FAA continues their evaluation of the Florida Metroplex project and more information will be made available as communicated by FAA.
- Hillsborough County Aviation Authority is committed to:
 - Community engagement on Metroplex.
 - Making sure residents and stakeholders are involved in the process to the greatest extent possible allowed by the FAA.
 - We welcome the opportunity to engage with your HOA to help encourage your community to participate in public FAA meetings, when they are scheduled.

Reminder – Scheduled Monthly Runway Closures

1st Wednesday of every month – Runway 1L-19R Closed between 7:30 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.

3rd Wednesday of every month – Runway 1R-19L Closed between 7:30 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.

IMPORTANT: The Airport is currently assessing the frequency and duration of scheduled monthly runway closures. Adjustments to maximize runway maintenance and required activities is expected and will be communicated over the coming weeks.
