

Fall/Winter Weather Patterns


- The winds are predominately from the north:
 - Aircraft arrive/depart to the North
 - Northeastern winter effects TPA operations:
 - Delays
 - Cancellations






Fall/Winter Weather Patterns Cont.

- Airport flow data
 - November 90% North Flow
 - October 69% North Flow
 - September 58% South Flow
 - August 72% South Flow

• Runway 1L/19R:

- Various Maintenance activities September 8 : 930 am 3
 pm
- Various Maintenance activities October 13 : 8 am 12 pm
- Various Maintenance activities November 10 : 8 am 12
 pm




East Runway Closures

Runway 1R/19L:


- Various Maintenance activities September 15: 630 am –
 230 pm
- Various Maintenance activities October 6, 15, & 16:8 am
 12 pm
- Various Maintenance activities November 16 & 17 : 8 am4 pm



Runway Closures Continued









Emergency Response Closures

- Corporate Jet October 22:
 - Issue: hydraulic failure
 - Aircraft Landed Safety and became disabled on Runway
 1L at 11:59pm
 - Passengers deplaned
 - Aircraft could not be towed main gear locked in place
 - Aircraft cleared of runway at 5:15am
 - Runway reopened at 6:06am





Emergency Response Closures Cont.

- United Flight October 24:
 - Issue: Nose gear issue
 - Aircraft Landed Safety and became disabled on Runway
 1L at 9:52pm
 - Aircraft could not steer and was towed clear of runway at 10:12pm



Upcoming **Prolonged** 2021/2022 Runway Closures

- Extended closures on **both** parallel runways are tentatively planned for the first half of 2022.
 Current dates are noted below:
 - 1R-19L: January 5 February 18, 2022
 - 1L-19R: April 20 June 3, 2022
- Closures are necessary for re-grading work on the south ends of both parallel runways that cannot be accomplished per regulatory requirements with the runways open to air traffic.
 - Runway closures are expected to last several weeks each and will be <u>continuous</u> closures (~45 days)

Noise Exposure Map Update

- The Authority is in the process of formally updating the Airport's Noise Exposure Map.
- This project formally kicked off in late 2019.
- Due to COVID-19, the first round of public outreach was delayed until October 2020.
- A second and final round occurred on October 12, 13, and 14, 2021:
- The project is currently expected to be completed in 2022.
