"An airport master plan is a comprehensive study of an airport and usually describes the short-, medium-, and long-term development plans to meet future aviation demand."

- FAA Advisory Circular 150/5070 – 6B – Airport Master Plans

Culminates with an updated Airport Layout Plan








Federal Aviation Administration Airport Improvement Program (AIP)




TPA's Master Plan Update – How often is it updated?





Total Unconstrained Passengers Forecast and Planning Activity Levels (PALs)











Refined Airport Needs to Serve PAL 1 (30.5 MAP; FY 2032)










